The following information should also be submitted to allow the City to promptly act on your claim:

- 1. Proof of the amount of the claim by means of either itemized receipts or two itemized estimates.
- A phone number where the claimant can be reached during business hours as well as the claimant's e-mail address, if any.
- 3. As detailed a description of the incident as possible, including the date, time and place.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Before you can file a lawsuit against the City of Milwaukee for reimbursement, State law requires that you first follow the claim procedures established by the City Clerk.

Filing a claim against the City does not automatically guarantee reimbursement from the City. However, the City examines each claim on an individual basis in determining if reimbursement is legally required.

In order to obtain reimbursement for a claim against the City, you must prove that the City wits employed acted unlawfully or negligently.

Only the City Attorney or the Common Council and the Mayor can authorize payment of a claim against the City. Any other representations made by City employees are not legally binding on the City.

893.80 Claims against governmental bodies or officers, agents or employees; notice of injury; limitation of damages and suits. (1) Except as provided in subs. (1g), (1m), (1p) and (8), no action may be brought or maintained against any volunteer fire company organized under ch. 213, political corporation, governmental subdivision or agency thereof nor against any officer, official, agent or employee of the corporation, subdivision or agency for acts done in their official capacity or in the course of their agency or employment upon a claim or cause of action unless:

Failure to give the requisite notice shall not bar action on the claim if the fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency had actual notice of the claim and the claimant shows to the satisfaction of the court that the delay or failure to give the requisite notice has not been prejudicial to the defendant fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency or to the defendant officer, official, agent or employee; and
- (b) A claim containing the address of the claimant and an itemized statement of the relief sought is presented to the appropriate clerk or person who performs the duties of a clerk or secretary for the defendant fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency and the claim is disallowed.

RE: Damage To 2002 GMC Envoy during Stump Grinding Operations

On September 9th, 2014 Paula Oleszak took a call from a citizen at around 2:00 pm saying that his car was damaged by debris from a stump grinding on N 55th Street south of Center St. I responded to the location to meet with the citizen and do a damage report and take photos.

I spoke to Mr. Paetz and asked him what and where the damage was. He said that there were nicks and scuffs on the driver side of the vehicle that may be from debris that came from the stump grinding done across the street. I took photos of the side of the vehicle and asked if there were any specific marks or dents that he wanted me to specifically note or that he knew were not previously there. He stated that there were no dents, and he could not point out any marks specifically that were due to this instance. He stated that he was sure there were other "parking lot dings" that were already there, but believed some of them were due to the stump grinding debris. He asked that I also photograph the rocks and debris on the road as he believed this came from the grinding. Mr. Paetz stated he tried to speak to the worker near his truck, who was wearing hearing protection, to ask him about the debris but he did not respond. He stated the work finished shortly after that and the workers proceeded to clean up the street and debris near the stump/hole and once complete they left.
