Whyte stated she discovered bullet holes in a window of the building and that the window was intact on Saturday 01/17/09 at 2:20 am. Business security cameras did not cover the area of incident and there were no security cameras on nearby buildings to view possible surveillance. A report was filed.
- 7. On 01/14/10, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 831 S 1st Street for a Property Damage complaint. Investigation revealed a patron from the club had been in an unrelated physical altercation in the parking lot with the driver of an unknown vehicle. After the altercation, the patron intentionally drove at the subject as he exited the business. The patron missed the victim but struck the building causing extensive damage. The suspect was later found and arrested.

8. On 06/17/12 at 12:16 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Battery complaint at St Francis Hospital. On 2-22-14, Squad 2450 (P.O. MARTINEZ and P.O. MALDONADO) was dispatched to a fight at 813 S 1st St (Solid Gold Gentlemen's Club). According to the CAD information, there was a father and a son physically fighting outside the location. Upon arrival, officers observed two subjects lying in the parking lot of the tavern holding onto each other. The subjects were identified as Jake R. LININGER (W/M 12-19-86) and Brian L. WETTLAUFER (W/M 01-21-57) and were step-son and step-father in relation. These subjects appeared to be highly intoxicated. I then spoke with the tavern owner, John A. URBAN (W/M 10-14-54) who stated that WETTLAUFER was causing a disturbance inside the tavern and wanted to fight the bartender. URBAN stated that WETTLAUFER was escorted outside by security and his step-son, LININGER. While outside, WETTLAUFER attempted to go back inside the business but LININGER held him back and began to wrestle with him in the parking lot. LININGER stated that he was trying to take WETTLAUFER to another tavern and leave Solid Gold, but WETTLAUFER refused and struggled with him. LININGER stated that WETTLAUFER and him were going from tavern to tavern, drinking that night, and Solid Gold was their last stop. LININGER stated that he called his mother and WETTLAUFER's wife to come pick them up and take them home. WETTLAUFER's wife arrived at Solid Gold and drove WETTLAUFER home.

LININGER did not wish for a citation to be issued against WETTLAUFER for the physical altercation in the parking lot and just wanted to get his step-father home safely. I did not observe any tavern violations during this investigation. The owner/licensee, URBAN, was notified that a tavern report was being filed regarding this incident.

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This report is written by P.O Francisco J CARTAGENA, assigned to district 2 on the late power shift.

On MON, 9-8-14, at 1:03am, while on Squad 2440 with P.O Timothy Zielisnki, we responded to 813 S 1st St to back up Squad 2479 who was at the address regarding a battery they had come across. While on our way, squad 2479 broadcasted over Milwaukee Police radio that a gun had been recovered after they heard shots fired in the area. Squad 2479 (P.O JUSTUS and P.O RIVERA) recovered the gun from a subject who was involved in a fight with another subject in the parking lot of Solid Gold Gentlemen's Club (813 S 1st St).

On arrival I spoke to P.O JUSTUS and P.O RIVERA who stated they were at S 2nd and W Walker St facing east when they heard two gunshots coming just northeast of their location. P.O JUSTUS stated they traveled north on S 1st St towards National Av. P.O JUSTUS stated as they drove past the parking lot of 813 S 1st St (Solid Gold Gentlemen's Club) he observed a White or Hispanic male bent over at the waist as if he was cowering with no shirt on and another Hispanic or White male wearing a White T-shirt and holding a handgun to the other subjects head. P.O JUSTUS and P.O RIVERA stated they quickly made a U-turn on S 1st St, and P.O JUSTUS exited his vehicle with his duty weapon drawn to confront the subject as P.O RIVERA was broadcasting the possible battery in progress. P.O JUSTUS stated he confronted the subject with the weapon and ordered him to show his hands several times before subject actually comply with the legal commands. P.O JUSTUS then ordered the subject to the ground in a prone position to conduct ground handcuffing to place subject in custody. P.O JUSTUS then took control of the subject's weapon, which he had put in a holster located on his waistband. P.O JUSTUS identified the shirtless man as Juan R PAGAN, W/M, 2-27-72 and the subject holding the gun with the white shirt as Gianfranco V TORRES, W/M, 10-25-87. Both subject were placed under arrest. It was later determined TORRES was a patron at the club before he walked outside and became involved in the fight with PAGAN.

I spoke to the manager in charge of the establishment in the night of the incident, PENDOWSKI, Jessica A, W/F, 3-16-79. PENDOWSKI indicated at the time of the incident she was in the second floor office taking care of some paper work. PENDOWSKI stated one of her dancers walked into the office and told her they were shooting outside. PENDOWSKI stated she told all the dancers to come upstairs and for the security guards to close the doors for the safety of the patrons and the workers. PENDOWSLKI stated she did not know who called the Police but that they arrived pretty quickly. There are surveillance cameras at the location but PENDOWSKI stated she did not have access to the system. The Owner was contacted and he eventually provided video of the incident.

P.O JUSTUS recovered two .40 spent casings on the parking lot of 813 S 1st St (Solid Gold Gentlemen's Club). A Red Chevrolet Impala bearing WI 294-VBY, that was parked in the parking lot of 813 S 1St St (Solid Gold Gentlemen's Club) was struck by a bullet on the front driver side quarter panel. During the search for evidence it was also revealed that the building (107 E National Av) located directly across the street from 813 S 1st St was also struck by a round.
