### 5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

St. Vincent de Paul Society and All Peoples Church have entered into a shared mission to address the issues of hunger and food insecurity in our community. Working collaboratively allows the two organizations to expand capacity and better serve the most vulnerable in our neighborhood. This shared mission will operate out of what will be known as "The Haramabee Kitchen" located at All Peoples Church.

This shared mission will require remodeling of the kitchen area of All Peoples Church including new kitchen equipment and upgrades to satisfy City of Milwaukee code requirements including upgrading existing door openings and add new panic hardware for better ADA accessibility and exiting requirements. The City of Milwaukee Health Department standards also need to be met including two required pieces of mechanical equipment to be located outside. The first is a Make Up Air Unit (MAU-1) and the second is a Kitchen Hood Exhaust Fan (FF-1). Another proposed exhaust for the Dishwasher (FF-2) has been eliminated from consideration.

In July 2014, James Bendtsen of All Peoples Church had an office review with Paul. At that time, Paul stated that the locations of these two pieces of equipment would require the approval of the Historic Preservation Commission. It would go before the commissioners with a recommendation of staff approval. The second purpose of the meeting was to determine exactly what documents would be be required in order to obtain approval. The documents have been submitted according to Paul's direction.



The Direct Gas Fired Make-Up Air package is designed to deliver tempered make-up air for installations requiring frequent air changes. Units are designed for natural and propane gas applications, and for indoor or outdoor installation.



Direct Gas-Fired Heater, ETL Listed, for use in tempering make-up air. Packages are certified to the ANSI Z83.4a-2001/CSA 3.7a-2001 combined safety standard and are available in sizes up to 2,500,000 BTUH and 21,000 CFM. Standard features include intermittent spark ignition system with timed safety lockout, and redundant gas valves. Units consist of a galvanized enclosure with an elevated gas burner which burns directly in the air stream. The burner consists of non-clogging, stainless steel combustion baffles attached to a aluminum gas supply section. The burner is capable of 100% thermal efficiency with a maximum turndown ratio of 30 to 1. The products of combustion mix with the make-up air which is introduced into the heater intake directly from outside the building. The burner module has a standard horizontal inlet and discharge duct connection and is located upstream of the blower module. The blower module has a standard horizontal inlet designed to accommodate an outside air inlet hood with standard 2" filters and screen.

To satisfy a variety of installation requirements, packages are available in a number of configurations which include additions of either a v-bank or an evaporative cooler intake module. All modules bolt together to form a rigid common base structure that mounts onto a single curb structure.

Combination packages that include both exhaust and supply fans mounted on a single roof curb are also available, please contact your sales representative for more information.




