File # 020827 is a resolution relative to the application, acceptance and funding of the SURVNET Grant by the Milwaukee Health Department.

### Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the SURVNET Project from the Centers for Disease Control through the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services.
- 2. This is a grant continuation.

### **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of the project is to maintain a countywide system for reporting communicable diseases in Milwaukee.
- 2. SURVNET is a countywide communicable disease surveillance system.
- 3. Physicians, laboratories, and other health providers are required to report communicable diseases. This reporting facilitates rapid identification and response by the department to disease clusters and outbreaks as well as unusual disease events.
- 4. Reportable diseases include food borne and waterborne illness that requires prompt public health intervention.
- 5. In 2001, 2,287 Milwaukee County cases representing 30 communicable diseases were reported to SURVNET. This report included 1,793 for the City of Milwaukee.
- 6. This grant encompasses the period of July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003.

### Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$50,000, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. This grant funds on existing Office Assistant III position, SG 425 with salary and fringe benefits (\$44,500).

3. The grant budget provides for \$5,100 for *Services* including GIS mapping services and training expenses.
