In the Salary Ordinance, under Pay Range 810, a footnote pertaining to the title "Police Electronic Technician" reads as follows: "1/ Positions to be reclassified to Electronic Technician upon becoming vacant." This footnote was originally contained in a classification report dated June 2, 1994, which was approved by the Fire and Police Commission on June 8, 1994, and by the Finance Committee on June 22, 1994 (File #940280), passed by the Common Council on June 28, 1994 (File #940012), and still remains in effect in the 2002 Salary Ordinance.

The attached letter from the Fire and Police Commission requests that one position of Police Electronic Technician be reclassified to the civilian position of Electronic Technician. Since the procedure to reclassify vacant positions to Electronic Technician was recommended by the Department of Employee Relations, approved by the Fire and Police Commission and authorized in the Salary Ordinance by Common Council action, we are requesting that the Positions Ordinance amendment necessary to implement the requested classification change for this recent vacancy (and future vacancies) be handled administratively.

In order to implement this change, the Positions Ordinance needs to be amended as follows:

In the Police Department, Administration/Services Decision Unit, Technical Services Bureau, Communications Maintenance Division, delete one position of "Police Electronic Technician," and add one position of "Electronic Technician."


I, therefore, request that one position of Police Electronic Technician be reclassified to Electronic Technician.
