Also interviewed regarding this investigation were Officers John GRABER, Michael BRANSKI, Steven LELINSKI, Justin CARLONI, Michael FISCHER, David BRGWORDT, Jeffrey KAMINSKI, and Anthony KNOX.

Officers GRABER and BRANSKI gave statements advising that when they arrived on the scene, MCCARTER was already in custody so they left the scene without having contact with him. All other officers refused to make statements per Attorney Jon CERMELE.

CONCLUSION:

MCCARTER would be unable to participate in any further investigations of this incident and is unavailable for District Attorney review. MCCARTER is unable to identify the officer(s) alleged to be involved in this incident. Subsequently, no probable cause can be established against any officer involved in this investigation. At this time, it is not possible to substantiate the essential elements necessary per state statutes. Therefore, this case is cleared unfounded/baseless.
