the scene when KING was arrest but did not see circumstances there. ALEJANDRE did state that he was at District #2 when KING was brought in and that he, ALEJANDRE, was in the booking room when he saw KING brought into the booking room. He stated that KING, while in the booking room, was arguing with officers and that the officers had a hard time handcuffing him to the bench. ALEJANDRE stated that KING was struggling with officers and that there were about three officers trying to get him cuffed. He stated that KING was struggling big time. ALEJANDRE was shown a photo of KING by Detective LEVENHAGEN and I.D. KING as being the black male that he saw struggling with police at District #2.

All of the above indicate that Anthony KING was not being truthful with Detective LEVENHAGEN when he said he was completely compliant and did not give the officers a hard time. All of KING'S complaint concerned things he stated happened at District #2 which he stated were done to him by Officer BOHLEN. Officers LEHNERT and MEDINA who were not part of KING'S complaint both stated in interviews that KING was completely uncooperative and that he was kicking at officers in the wagon. KING'S witness, ALEJANDRE, also indicated that KING was lying in that ALEJANDRE states that KING was not cooperative with officers. Because of all the inconsistencies in KING'S statement along with the fact that there were no visible injuries other than the injury to KING'S chin, which was reported by officers at the time of the incident and was done in the course of a lawful arrest without use of excessive force this case is being made baseless. There is no evidence of battery or excessive force used against Anthony KING in this incident. This ends this case pending any new information that may come forward in the future.
