The claim is in the amount of \$569.64, including \$8.64 in disbursements, for 5.10 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter. Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved an arrest for OWI.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled Luebbe to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

CONCLUSION:

On Wednesday, December 13, 2000, this case was ordered in to the District Attorney's office where it was reviewed by Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN. In reviewing this case Deputy DA REDDIN stated that P.O. Christopher BLASZAK observed GOMEZ chasing someone in his car. P.O. BLASZAK interviewed the person being chased and was told that GOMEZ had displayed a gun a short time earlier. P.O. BLASZAK then spoke to GOMEZ who was intoxicated and became belligerent during the questioning. At some point it was decided to place GOMEZ under arrest. While P.O. BLASZAK and Sgt. DOFFEK attempted to handcuff GOMEZ, GOMEZ continued to resist and at one point raised his arm, which had a hard cast on it, and appeared ready to strike P.O. BLASZAK. At this point P.O. BLASZAK delivered a focus strike to GOMEZ'S nose, breaking it.

P.O. BLASZAK had a right to use force sufficient to prevent Mr. GOMEZ from striking him with the cast and to effectuate the arrest of GOMEZ. The force used under the circumstances of GOMEZ'S intoxicated, belligerent and violent behavior was objectively reasonable and for that reason Deputy DA REDDIN declined to prosecute any type of criminal charges regarding P.O. BLASZAK. This complaint is cleared as warrant refused.
