Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Robert O'Grosky. The claim is in the amount of \$715.00 for 6.50 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officer on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

The above-named police officer has retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent him, and as he was performing the duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved transporting a juvenile in custody from the district station to PPS and then to the Children's Center.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When he requested counsel, IAD compelled O'Grosky to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officer. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered. Because the incident involved a juvenile, I have deleted his name in the DA's letter.

Dear Chief Jones:

On December 21, 2000. a juvenile, was arrested by City of Milwaukee Police officers for Burglary. Detectives took his shoes as evidence. Thereafter he was transported by officer Robert O'Grosky from #4 to the Police Administration Building, to Children's Court and then to the hospital for medical clearance. alleges that he was made to walk outside in the snow and ice without shoes.

Investigation revealed that was given shoes at the Children's Court Center prior to being taken for medical clearance (although he first denied this, he later agreed that it was true).

While walking barefoot in the cold was no doubt uncomfortable, suffered no injuries and there is no intent on the part of officer O'Grosky, at least none that I can discern, to cause harm to . These are two key elements of the crime of Physical Abuse of a Child. Since neither is present, criminal charges are not appropriate.
