LENKOSKI on September 10, 2000. Both officers denied kneeing or kicking Mr. LENKOSKI stating that they only used that force that was reasonable to effect his arrest.

### **CONCLUSION:**

Both Mr. LENKOSKI and Mr. CHEANEY refused to cooperate in the investigation of this matter. Additionally, numerous witnesses provided several different conflicting statements as to what had occurred in regards to this matter. Witnesses did state that both Officers RANDAZZO and ANDERSON did identify themselves as police officers and even showed their badges and identification at the time they effected the arrest of Brian LENKOSKI. For all of these reasons ADA Thomas MCADAMS declined to issue any criminal charges against Officer RANDAZZO and the complaint was subsequently cleared as warrant refused.
