Additionally, P.O. WARREN as well as three other police officers involved in this incident gave a detailed statement and denied the complainant's allegations. Furthermore, no additional witnesses were developed during the course of the investigation

· CONCLUSION:

On Tuesday, November 28, 2000, Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN reviewed this case and decided not to issue any type of criminal charges. He based his decision on the fact that there is insufficient evidence to issue battery charges in this case. Therefore, this incident will be cleared as warrant refused.
