

Pierce St. (ST21210101) File  
Number 140703: Concrete alley  
pavement reconstruction, replace  
some abutting walk of driveway  
approaches, grading, and storm  
drainage facilities where necessary.  
(Assessable Alley Paving Fund --  
\$17,000; Nonassessable Alley  
Paving Fund -- \$135,000). The total  
estimated cost for this project  
including the requested amount is  
\$160,000. This project is anticipated  
to be completed during the 2015  
construction season.

11th Aldermanic District  
S. 53rd St. - W. Montana St. to  
W. Cleveland Ave. (ST211140101)  
File Number 140430: Asphalt pave-  
ment resurfacing, replace curb and  
gutter, sidewalk and driveway  
approaches where necessary,  
sodding (7-foot width of tree border

Reconstruction Paving Fund --
