# JAMES CARROLL

File #021700 is a resolution authorizing and providing for the sale by the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin of a series of Sewerage System revenue bonds, Series 2003 S4.

#### **Background and Discussion**

- 1. The 2000 Budget transferred the funding for the Relief and Relay sewer capital program from the City's Capital Improvement Budget to the Sewer Maintenance Fund.
- 2. The 2003 Budget includes \$17,750,000 for new sewerage system revenue bond borrowing and \$16,138,500 in carryover borrowing, for a total \$33,888,500.
- 3. The Public Debt Commission anticipates selling the bonds in April.
- 4. The resolution authorizes the Public Debt Commission to issue and sell City of Milwaukee Sewerage System revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$33,888,500.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

The Comptroller's Office estimates 2003 expenditures of approximately \$1.4 million for debt service in 2003 and \$2.6 million per year in years 2003-2023. (Funding for the Sewerage System revenue bond's debt service is provided by Sewer Maintenance Fund, not the tax levy.)
