This incident involved a juvenile arrest.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officer initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When he requested counsel, IAD compelled PO Padovano to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officer. Reddin no processed the complaint, but no reports are available since it involved a juvenile. Attached is an itemization of the time and services rendered.
