File # 021746 is a resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of the Healthy Homes Demonstration Project Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to accept and fund the Healthy Homes Demonstration Grant Project from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. This demonstration project will serve approximately 75 families who have children with moderate to severe asthma.
- 2. Families will receive home environmental assessment for asthma triggers and home interventions to reduce asthma triggers such as dust mites, cockroach infestation and mold.
- 3. This demonstration project will be an integral component of a comprehensive asthma initiative led by Children's Hospital of Wisconsin-Fight Asthma Milwaukee Allies. As a demonstration project, important data will be collected and analyzed and evaluate various interventions for asthma prevention and treatment.
- 4. The grant encompasses the period of March 1, 2003 through August 31, 2005.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$1,035,674. \$700,000 (67%) will be provided by the grantor and (33%) will be provided by the city. The city share of the grant project will, for the most part, be funded by state consolidated contract dollars.
- 2. 49% of the \$700,000 in grantor funding will support the following MHD positions:
 - 1 existing Project Coordinator, SG 05
 - 1 new Environmental Health Specialist II, SG 541
 - 1 new Public Health Nurse, SG 666

- 3. Existing MHD positions supported through city funding include the Home Environmental Health Manager, 1 Office Assistant II and 1 Chemist II.
- 4. 39% (\$277,905) of the grantor funding is budgeted for subcontracts for program evaluation, lab quality assurance, housing decontamination and repair and pest control.
- 5. Approximately 10% of the grantor funds will be used for program supplies and materials, miscellaneous services and laboratory equipment.
