File # 021790 is a resolution appropriating an additional \$30,000 from the Outside Counsel-Expert Witness Special Purpose Account to retain an outside attorney to represent the City of Milwaukee and Fire and Police Commission in *Arthur Jones v. City* of Milwaukee – Fire and Police Commission, EEOC Charge No. 260A200714.

Background

- 1. Chief of Police Arthur L. Jones has filed a charge of discrimination against the City of Milwaukee/Fire and Police Commission with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) alleging that he has been subjected to harassment, public denunciation, referred to in a racially derogatory manner and subjected to a hostile work environment in violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
- 2. Council File # 020385 authorized the appropriation of \$25,000 from the Outside Counsel-Expert Witness fund for the purpose of hiring an outside counsel for this case.

Discussion

- 1. The City Attorney's Office is currently representing the Chief in various pending cases. An attorney may not act as an advocate against a person that the attorney is representing, even if the cases are wholly unrelated.
- 2. In this case, outside counsel must be retained in order to represent the City of Milwaukee and the Fire and Police Commission.
- 3. Common Council authorization is required in order to retain an attorney outside of the City Attorney's permanent staff for the purpose of representing the city.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this resolution is \$30,000, from the Outside Counsel-Expert Witness Special Purpose Account. Upon approval of this resolution, \$55,000 will have been appropriated for this case.
- 2. The current balance of the 2003 Outside Counsel-Expert Witness Special Purpose Account is \$205,488. Upon approval of this resolution, this account will have a 2003 balance of \$175,488.
