This is to inform you that three grant applications were submitted to the Wisconsin Land Information Board (WLIB) by the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission acting on behalf of Milwaukee County. These three grant applications—part of the WLIB 2002 grant distribution—applied for funding in the total amount of \$200,368 (\$99,000 for one application and \$50,684 for each of the second and third applications) to prepare digital cadastral mapping for an area of approximately 12 square miles in the City of Milwaukee (about 10,900 total land ownership parcels). We have recently been notified that all three of these grant applications were approved.

Please be advised that the work governed by the grant funds must be carried out under guidelines promulgated by the Wisconsin Land Information Board and that the proposed work must be completed within a period of 18 months. At the time the WLIB approves the final grant agreements, a project start date and a project completion date will be established by the WLIB. Accordingly, Commission staff will notify you when the WLIB has established these dates. An agreement for each of the three separate applications providing the specific technical details related to the computer transformation will follow shortly.

We look forward to continuing to work with the City on this project.
