Dear Mr. Smokowicz:

In your letter of December 9, 2002 (copy enclosed), you asked for an indication that the legal services performed on behalf of Officer Guth fell within the terms of the statute. I represented Officer Guth in the criminal investigation concerning Courtney Turner's interrogation and custody. Officer Guth was questioned about his role in that interrogation and contact with Mr. Turner.

Mr. Turner claimed that Officer Guth had been directly outside the interrogation room when Det. Shaw allegedly struck him in the head and face multiple times, and that Guth "heard him whippin' my ass." While Det. Shaw was the focus of the battery investigation, Mr. Turner's allegations included claims that Guth was aware of the battery and did nothing about it, and in fact, supported Shaw's contention that he had not hit Mr. Turner.

Mr. Turner's allegations, if believed, would support not only a battery investigation against Det. Shaw, but also a misconduct in public office investigation against Officer Guth. The fact that Officer Guth was not the "target" of the battery investigation would not be a bar to prosecuting him as the "target" of misconduct in public office charges if Mr. Turner's allegations were believed. As a result, it is appropriate for the City to pay for Guth's representation.
