#### **Dear Council Members:**

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Michael Edmonds for attorney's fees for representing Lieutenant of Police Officer Terrence Gilbert. The claim is in the amount of \$1,353.00 for 12.30 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. Criminal charges were brought against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed, but he was ultimately acquitted.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Terrence Gilbert, a Milwaukee police officer retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent him, and as he was performing the duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees.

On June 28, 1997, P.O. Gilbert, while off-duty, was driving southbound in the 5100 block of North 91st Street when he heard the sound of breaking glass under his tires. He turned his auto around and drove back to investigate. At 5123 North 91st Street, someone splashed liquid on his windshield.

P.O. Gilbert exited the vehicle and observed three males run from the median. He yelled for the males to stop and return to the scene. They declined to do so. P.O. Gilbert pursued on foot. P.O. Gilbert grabbed one of the males and identified himself as a Milwaukee police officer, thus placing himself on-duty.

The male whom P.O. Gilbert stopped subsequently alleged that P.O. Gilbert pointed a gun at him. Charges were brought, dismissed and reinstated. P.O. Gilbert obtained other counsel (Boyle, Boyle and Smith, which may be submitting a separate bill to you regarding this matter) for trial and was subsequently acquitted.

You requested additional information from this office concerning the above claim. You inquired whether Officer Gilbert switched attorneys because he deemed our services inappropriate or unnecessary.

Officer Gilbert has informed me that he did not deem our services either inappropriate or unnecessary, particularly where Attorney Edmonds' representation resulted in the dismissal of the initial charges. Officer Gilbert informs me that he considered that representation quite useful. Our office also represented Officer Gilbert on the state's review of the dismissal, including briefing and a hearing.

Officer Gilbert's particular reasons for selecting Jerry Boyle to represent him in the criminal case when charges were again brought are not material to this claim, although many defendants have chosen to use Mr. Boyle's services when threatened with loss of liberty. I hear he is very capable. Suffice it to say that Officer Gilbert did not switch attorneys due to inappropriate, unnecessary, or unprofessional conduct.
