File # 030899 is a resolution relative to acceptance of private contributions for improvements to the Bremen Street Neighborhood Play Area, located at North Bremen Street and East Burleigh Street, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Aldermanic District in the City of Milwaukee.

# **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Department of Public Works (DPW) Buildings and Fleet Services to accept up to \$30,000 in private contributions and material for the reconstruction of the City of Milwaukee's Bremen Street Neighborhood Play Area.
- 2. The acceptance of these funds and material are on a one-time, designated basis.

## Discussion

- 1. This resolution will authorized DPW-Buildings and Fleet Services to accept private contributions and materials for improvements to the Bremen Street Play area, most likely for landscaping and artwork; enhancements for the play area.
- 2. This offer of funds and materials has come from interested neighbors in the area and not from a specific organized community group.
- 3. This improvement project includes the removal of the existing asphalt playground; walks and children's play equipment and the installation of new play equipment, benches, walks and landscaping.

## Fiscal Impact

- The total amount of money and material specified in this resolution is up to \$30,000, entirely from neighbors in the area of the Bremen Street Neighborhood Play Area. Monetary donations will be placed in a special purpose account within DPW-Buildings and Fleet Services for expenditure of the contributions.
- 2. This play area improvement project is further funded with \$15,000 in the 2003 Recreational Facilities Capital Improvements Program and \$45,000 (money available to complete the required improvements-\$60,000) in Community Development Block Grant Funds for a total of up to \$90,000.
- 3. There is no tax levy impact associated with the adoption of this resolution.
