File # 030895 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a 2003 COPS Mobile Digital Radios and Crime Mapping Technologies Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a 2003 COPS Mobile Digital Radios and Crime Mapping Technologies Grant from the United States Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services.
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to reduce crime and improve public safety using technology.
- 2. This equipment portion of this federal grant is designated specifically for the purchase of data communication technology.
- 3. Projected purchases through this grant include mobile data computers and the necessary software and licensing, 3 radio sites and complementary infrastructure.
- 4. This digital conversion is a continuing effort to comply with the FCC regulations for digital conversion.
- 5. This grant encompasses the period of October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$2,998,435, with \$2,980,500 provided by the grantor and \$17,935 provided by the city. The city share covers indirect costs associated with grant administration for the ITMD portion of the grant.
- 2. \$2,808,209 of this grant is budgeted for digital equipment purchases as a component of the required digital conversion of the MPD radio infrastructure.
- 3. \$172,291 of this grant will be sub-granted to the City of Milwaukee, Department of Administration, Information and Technology Management Division. This

funding will be applied to existing COMPASS-related salaries and projected expenditures including:

- Salaries and fringe benefits for 1 existing Systems Coordinator, SG 07 and 1 existing Programmer Analyst, SG 598, \$146,291 total
- \$17,000 for software licensing
- \$9,000 for 2 GIS Work Stations and 1 Color Printer
