We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the city Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimants, Tyronne & LaTonya LeSueur, 3603 North 10th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53212, allege that on July 31, 2003 they sustained damage to their legally parked vehicle when it was struck by an auto fleeing the Milwaukee Police Department at North 14th Street and West Wright Street. They claim damages in the amount of \$6,005.00.

Our investigation reveals that the City of Milwaukee Police acted appropriately when they attempted to stop this vehicle because the driver of said vehicle was engaged in criminal activity; and as such, the City of Milwaukee would not be liable. Accordingly, we recommend that this claim be denied.
