For the past five years, DNS received approximately \$120,000 in revenue for required permits obtained by the owner and for fire inspection fees. This amount covers all three buildings (two tax key numbers). Any alterations, modifications plus exhibit/functions (pyrotechnics, auto displays, temporary structures) for these buildings will continue to require permits and therefore inspections. This amount of revenue will be lost which is counted as part of DNS's budget.

Please also note that the proposed ordinance change is an exemption for building code related permits only. Is it intended to include annual fire inspection fees? Section 214-7-2-b-2 currently exempts properties owned by the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, State of Wisconsin and Federally owned building from the annual fire inspection fee.
