File # 031031 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Beat Patrol Program Grant.

### **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Beat Patrol Program from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance.
- 2. This is a continuing grant.

### Discussion

- 1. The purpose of the Beat Patrol program is to work with neighborhood residents to identify and resolve crime and quality of life issues that impact upon the local area.
- 2. This grant funds 6 existing full time Police Officer positions with salary and fringe benefits for this program within the MPD  $2^{nd}$  District.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004.

## Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$525,864 with \$150,000 provided by the grantor and \$375,656 provided by the city. The city share includes indirect costs (\$116,023) associated with grant administration.
- 2. The city portion of this grant is included in the 2004 MPD operations budget.
