EBE Participation in Development Projects

We must set realistic and achievable goals for EBE participation—otherwise all we succeed in doing is driving up costs.

Minority population has increased, but-just because there is a significant jump in minority population, it does not mean that EBE businesses/certifications have grown proportionately. The actual percentage of EBE firms in the various industries must be considered when establishing goals.

Currently, Milwaukee doesn't have enough EBE firms that provide <u>all</u> the types of goods and services required in development projects.

From DCD's perspective, we have been able to meet and at times, even exceed requirements in the following areas:

- electrical
- plumbing
- roofing
- landscaping
- demolition
- flooring
- masonry

On the other hand, in the following areas we have been unable to meet existing EBE requirements:

- fire protection
- hangar doors
- hollow metal doors
- environmental remediation
- refrigeration
- elevators
- sheet metal work
