Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Montell Carter and Christopher Heidemann. The claim is in the amount of \$429.00 for 3.90 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officers on whose behalf this claim was filed, but they were ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them, and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved a foot chase resulting in a suspect being taken into custody.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled PO Heidemann to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21.

Later, the MPD decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. The MPD did not create a clearance report regarding the officers. Attached is an itemization of the time and services rendered.
