CHANGE TEN-HOUR PARKING METER RATES

FROM TWENTY CENTS PER HOUR TO TWENTY-FIVE CENTS PER HOUR

Dear Chairperson:

Currently, there are two separate rates for ten-hour meters in the City of Milwaukee Central Business District (CBD), twenty cents an hour and twenty-five cents an hour. To maintain consistency within the CBD we recommend the following areas be changed to twenty-five cents per hour:
