MR. OWCZARSKI: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. This ordinance before you pertains to the special dance -- tavern dancing permits that may be issued to licensed tavern establishments in the city. As you are all aware, there is currently a vacancy on the Common Council. This is an unusual, by the likes of our code, circumstance in which a permit license -- a permit in this instance is granted largely at the discretion of the Common Council member. Given this vacancy, there was a concern, what is done in those instances? To whom does the tavernkeeper apply? Is there a due process? Et cetera. What this ordinance seeks to do is answer that question. In addition, the answer that we gave is that individuals who do not have a Common Council representative will have their request for permit heard by this committee with an appeal to the Common Council. It was also thought

prudent at this time to provide due process to the

In those instances where there is a Common Council representative, that Common 2 Council representative still makes the determination, 3 but we provide objective criteria that he or she may 4 use in making that determination, and we do, indeed, 5 provide an appeal to this committee. That committee 6 review, however, is final. In both instances there is 7 8 one level of review. 9 CHAIRMAN BOHL: And again, the last of the measures you discussed was a concern presented by the 10 11 City Attorney that we were not adequately providing due process and, therefore, the present system did not 12 13 stand up to legal muster. This should allow us to do 14 just that. 15 Mr. Schrimpf, anything you want to add? 16 MR. SCHRIMPF: Nope. 17 CHAIRMAN BOHL: Briefly? Questions by 18 committee? 19 ALDERMAN GORDON: Mr. Chairman, I would like to be added as a co-sponsor, and I will move approval. 20 21 CHAIRMAN BOHL: Let the record reflect 22

Alderman Gordon as a co-sponsor. And Alderman Gordon would move adoption of the substitute.
