HERBERT M. HALDEMANN, by his attorney Alan D. Eisenberg, submits the following as and for his Notice of Claim for Damages:

- On or about Saturday, Wednesday, April 2nd, 2003 at or about 4:27 P.M. at or near 4975 N. 53rd Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, for reasons unknown, 7th District MPD Officer Thomas Kline recklessly and brutally shot and killed "Credit" the eleven-year old female German Shepherd companion and family member of Claimant;
- 2. On or about Saturday, Wednesday, April 2nd, 2003 at or about 4:27 P.M. at or near 4975 N. 53rd Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, for reasons unknown, 7th District MPD Officer Thomas Kline caused pain, suffering and trauma to claimant by the vicious murder and excessive force used in the slaying of "Credit" having expended 2 rounds of ammunition into Credit's head causing suffering and death to Credit who was restrained and confined to claimant's property at all times by a 6 to 7 foot wooden fenced in yard which was properly secured;
- 3. On or about Wednesday, April 2nd, 2003 at or about 4:27 P.M. at or near 4975 N. 53rd Street, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, while illegally detained at MPD 7th District Police Station, Officer Thomas Kline maliciously and meanspiritedly told Complainant, "Oh, I shot your dog in the head," and later said, "I have something else to tell you I shot your dog **twice** in the head."

- Said actions by the City of Milwaukee, its officials and police officers who are sworn to uphold the law and serve and protect Milwaukee Citizens permitted Claimant to suffer further trauma and stress by failing to promptly offer any assistance to Claimant in the proper disposal of Claimant's companion dog and family member, "Credit;" and further provided knowingly false information about Claimant's ability to promptly bail himself out of the 7th District Station after all required citations had been issued and all other paperwork had been completed; further Claimant alleges and further complains that Claimant was disparately treated by being chained to a wall at the 7th District Police Station in a manner inconsistent with other persons being detained at the same time;
- Herbert M. Haldemann seeks damages and compensation in the amount of five hundred thousand (\$500,000.00) dollars and punitory damages in the amount of five hundred thousand (\$500,000.00) dollars and any other such just and equitable relief as may be granted.
