Please be advised that the Electrical Workers and their Contractors have an agreement providing for the following rates of wages and fringe benefits effective June 1, 2004.

Employer contribution paid into the **Health and Welfare Trust Fund** for Electrical Mechanic, Electrician Foreman and Electrician General (Area) Foreman is Six Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$6.65) per hour and is paid on all clock hours, **effective June 1**, 2004.

Employer contributions paid into the Vacation and Holiday Trust Fund are as follows on the basis of ten percent (10%) of gross earnings, hourly contribution for time worked at the straight time, effective June 1, 2004.

Employer contributions paid into the various fringe benefit trust funds for Painters, etc. listed above are as follows effective June 8,2004 through May 31, 2005, and paid on all hours worked to the Pension Trust Funds, on the first 44 hours worked per week to the Health & Welfare Fund and up to a maximum of 40 straight-time hours worked per week into the Industry Promotion Fund and the Joint Apprenticeship, Education and Training Trust Fund.
