The purpose of the grant is the prevention and control of West Nile virus through the use of 1) surveillance systems for the identification of mosquitoes that may be infected with West Nile 2) mosquito control through source reduction or chemical control of mosquito populations 3) public outreach and education on personal protection and source reduction of mosquito breeding habitat and the importance of this method of control in reducing the risk of mosquito-borne virus transmission.
