File # 040373 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Beach Monitoring Grant.

## Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for, accept and fund the Beach Monitoring Grant form the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
- 2. This is a continuing grant.

## **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this project is to implement bacterial monitoring of water quality at Wisconsin public beaches.
- 2. This monitoring is conducted on a seasonal basis, May through September.
- 3. This grant period extends from May through September 2004 with funding provided on an annual basis.

# **Fiscal Impact**

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$28,000, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. 54% of this grant partially funds 1 existing MHD position:
  - 1 Environmental and Disease Control Specialist, SG 547
- 3. 46% of this grant (\$8,077) funds supplies and materials for e-coli beach testing as well as a contract (\$4,200) with the Great Lakes Water Institute for automated monitoring at South Shore Beach.
