# JAMES CARROLL

File #040350 is a resolution appropriating \$21,919.26 from the Common Council Contingent Fund to supplement the 2004 Special Purpose Account-Firemen's Relief Fund.

### **Background**

- 1. The Firemen's Relief Fund Special Purpose Account is utilized to help defray the costs of the Fire Department Relief Association, established under Section 20-18 of the City Charter.
- 2. The City Fire Department Relief Association provides members death benefits. The members are active and retired Fire Department employees.
- 3. The funds received by the association through the Firemen's Relief Fund Special Purpose Account are invested in equities and fixed-income securities until distributed to beneficiaries.
- 4. The funding level for this SPA is established by City Charter (s.20.18-2) and is equivalent to 1/8 of the amount of the State Aids for Fire Insurance Premiums ("Fire Dues"). The funding level for the Firemen's Relief Fund reflects estimated changes in the State Fire Dues appropriation.
- 5. The 2004 budgeted appropriation for this SPA is \$90,000.
- 6. As of July 16, 2004, the Common Council Contingent Fund's balance was \$4,474,318.

#### Discussion

The fire insurance premiums received from the State were higher than appropriated in the 2004 Budget; the City's 2004 appropriation was based on prior year's experience. The amount of funding required by the City Charter is \$111,919.26. This is \$21,919.26 more than the \$90,000 appropriated for this purpose in 2004 Budget.

#### Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the expenditure of \$21,919.26 from the Common Council Contingent Fund.
