

In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Windows consist of one-over-one sash, fixed sash and casement windows. No existing windows will be replaced except for fixed windows at front. Should it be determined any other window needs replacement, it will replicated in wood to match the existing in type, size, shape and thickness. All leaded glass windows to remain. Lead paint will be abated/treated at the window openings. Wood storms will be installed at all of the windows. No vinyl, vinyl clad, aluminum, aluminum clad, or fiberglass windows will be installed.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
