The County of Uasin Gishu, Republic of Kenya, and the City of Scottsdale, Arizona, United States of America, agree to establish a sister city relationship.


Uasin Gishu and Scottsdale agree:

- To enhance mutual understanding and friendship between the Kenyan and American people through the development of friendly exchanges and cooperation between Uasin Gishu and Scottsdale in the areas of education, healthcare, arts and culture, youth, environmental, economic development, and municipal governance.
- To organize exchange and cooperation in other areas in which there is mutual benefit and interest.
- To further organize the Sister City efforts of both Uasin Gishu and Scottsdale through the establishment of Sister City committees involving citizens of the communities and the selection of a chairperson representing each Sister City organization.
- To maintain regular communication between representatives of the citizen committees.

Uasin Gishu and Scottsdale believe that such cooperation and exchanges will promote the mutual understanding and welfare of their citizens, and the cultural and economic prosperity of both communities.

This agreement is signed in two copies by the Governor of the County of Uasin Gishu and the Mayor of the City of Scottsdale.


