
New wood windows will replace fire damaged ones in multi-unit apartment building. All wood must be painted upon completion. Please note that research has shown that if new bare wood is exposed to the exterior elements for a period of only a week or two the life expectancy of the paint job will be decreased. Glass in the windows must be clear. No low-e of tinted glass.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
