The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolution for Common Council approval.

<u>Lead Demonstration Project Grant</u> - This new grant funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will make an additional 1,295 housing units lead-safe and to contract with a community-based organization to assure lead-safe and habitable housing in the target area. Changes to the positions ordinance are incorporated in the resolution.

<u>Lead Outreach Grant</u> - Funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, this new grant award will assist in the development and implementation of intensive and coordinated education, screening and housing advocacy in the Lead Program's target area.

<u>Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant</u> - This new grant is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to make an additional 870 housing units lead-safe and to contract with community-based organizations in support of neighborhood prevention activities. Changes to the positions ordinance are incorporated in the resolution

<u>HIV Women's Project</u> - This continuing grant from the Medical College of Wisconsin provides public health nursing case management to a targeted population of HIV infected women and their families.

<u>Urban Area Security Initiative Grant</u> - This resolution amends Common Council Files 040128 and 040057 which approved the acceptance and expenditure of these grant funds. The amendment is needed to add an additional Health Department position to the Positions Ordinance.
