Common Council File 041039 contains a resolution from the Milwaukee Health Department relative to the acceptance and funding of the Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant. This new \$3,532,285 grant was awarded by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. It is comprised of \$3,000,000 in grantor share and \$532,285 in City matching funds. The grant period is January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007.

The purpose of the grant is to make an additional 870 housing units lead-safe and to contract with community-based organizations in support of neighborhood prevention activities. It will contribute to decreasing childhood lead poisoning and increase the number of lead-safe housing units in Milwaukee.

This grant will fund a number of positions including:

One Lead Hazard Prevention Manager Three Lead Risk Assessor II One Health Project Coordinator Lead One Chemist II One Lab Assistant II (.5 FTE) One Program Assistant II (.5 FTE)

The city in kind share includes contracts for lead abatement on properties and indirect costs to administer the grant.

RECOMMENDATION: APPROVE THE RESOLUTION RELATING TO ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF THE LEAD BASED PAINT HAZARD CONTROL GRANT.
