Per Model 4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/23/2014 Milwaukee police responded to an injured person complaint at 720 North Milwaukee Street (720 Nightclub). Investigation revealed the injured party was walking down the stairs to exit the business when she lost her footing and fell down. Employees from the business summoned emergency services, and the injured party was conveyed to Columbia St. Mary's hospital where she was treated for several injuries.
- 2. On 05/03/2014 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Apartment 720 (720 North Milwaukee Street) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof that she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
- 3. On 06/01/2014 Milwaukee police officers were posted in the 700 block of North Milwaukee Street to assist with the disbursement of patrons when the business's located in that area closed. Employees from Apartment 720 (720 North Milwaukee Street) were helpful and assisted Milwaukee police officers move customers away from the entry to the business. A fight broke out at 730 N Milwaukee. During the fight one subject was observed by a sergeant, retrieving a firearm from the subject's auto. The sergeant arrested the subject.

This report is submitted by P.O. Josh POST who is assigned to District One, Late-Power Shift.

On Sunday, 02-23-14 at 2:16AM, Squad 1440 (P.O. Corstan COURT and myself) responded to the Apartment 720 Nightclub at 720 N. Milwaukee St. regarding an Injured/Sick complaint.

While on scene, I observed the injured subject in this offense, who was identified as Nyleen R. TRIMBORN (W/F, 11-25-57). TRIMBORN was sitting on the stairway of the entrance to the club and appeared to be bleeding from the head. Milwaukee Fire Department Engine 1 (Lt. MOES, Red Shift) was on scene treating TRIMBORN's injuries. TRIMBORN was conscious and appeared alert and was responsive to medical personnel. A short time after my arrival on scene, Bell Ambulance #406 responded and conveyed TRIMBORN to St. Mary's Hospital for further treatment.

I then spoke with a friend of TRIMBORN's who identified herself as Sandra L. KLEIN (W/F, 01-19-57). KLEIN stated that on today's date, she and TRIMBORN arrived at Apartment 720 with a group of females to celebrate a bachelorette party. KLEIN stated that she, TRIMBORN and other members of the party had been consuming alcohol since approximately 5:00PM on 02-22-14. KLEIN stated that she, TRIMBORN and the rest of the party left the nightclub at approximately 2:00AM. KLEIN stated that TRIMBORN began walking down the stairway of the nightclub to exit ahead of her. KLEIN stated that she walked behind TRIMBORN as she exited. KLEIN stated that as she walked down the steps, TRIMBORN appeared to have lost her footing and fell. KLEIN stated that TRIMBORN landed on the middle landing of the staircase and appeared to be bleeding from her head. KLEIN stated that TRIMBORN appeared unconscious and unresponsive. KLEIN stated that a worker at the nightclub summoned emergency services and she waited with TRIMBORN. KLEIN stated that a short time after her fall, TRIMBORN opened her eyes but did not speak or become verbally responsive until medical personnel arrived.

I then spoke with Kimberly M. KIRCHNER (W/F, 10-10-84) who stated that she is employed at Apartment 720 Nightclub as a host. KIRCHNER stated that on today's date, at approximately 2:00AM, she was standing just outside of the upper exit to the nightclub greeting patrons as they arrived and left. KIRCHNER stated that at that time, she observed a bachelorette party (including TRIMBORN) exiting the club. KIRCHNER stated that she said goodbye to the group and began tending to another customer when she heard a commotion on the stairwell. KIRCHNER stated that she observed that TRIMBORN had apparently fallen on the stairs and was bleeding from the head. KIRCHNER stated that she summoned emergency personnel and then stood outside of the nightclub in preparation for their arrival.

KIRCHNER stated that this stairwell, though dimly lit, was under video surveillance. KIRCHNER allowed me to view the surveillance which showed the bachelorette party (including TRIMBORN) exiting the nightclub at 1:53AM. The video showed what appeared to be TRIMBORN losing her footing on the stairwell as she descended and falling down. KIRCHNER was unable to provide a copy of the video to me on that night.

The scene of this incident is the Apartment 720 Nightclub which is located on the second floor of 720 North Milwaukee Street. Upon entering that address, there is a stairwell leading to the second level entrance to the nightclub. This stairwell had a small landing halfway to the top. Squad 1442 (P.O. Jeremy GREENE and Jeremy LIMBERG) responded and took photos of this offense at 2:43AM. Squad 1442 then changed locations to St. Mary's Hospital to photograph TRIMBORN's injuries. There, TRIMBORN was admitted at 2:42AM and treated by Dr. William TUCKER. Due to her injuries, TRIMBORN was taken away from her hospital room so that a series of medical tests could be performed. As such, TRIMBORN was unavailable to be interviewed regarding this incident at this time.

On Thursday, March 27th, 2014 at 10:27PM, I responded to the emergency room of Columbia St. Mary's Hospital (2301 N. Lake Dr.) to conduct follow-up regarding this investigation. There, I spoke with the

emergency room Health Unit Coordinator who identified herself as Geri SALYERS. SALYERS informed me that while admitted to the emergency room as a result of this incident, TRIMBORN was treated for trauma to her C-spine as well as other joints and long bones as well as a blunt head injury. Regarding this incident, SALYERS informed me that TRIMBORN was fitted for a left arm sling as a result of a left clavicle fracture. SALYERS stated that TRIMBORN also sustained a laceration to her forehead which required an undocumented amount of sutures to close.

Attempts to contact TRIMBORN via the telephone number she provided me (ph# 262-542-8951) was met with negative results. I did, however, leave a voice message for TRIMBORN to contact me regarding this incident.

On Friday, March 28th, 2014 at 7:58PM, I called and spoke with KIRCHNER regarding this incident. KIRCHNER informed me that the video surveillance that depicted this incident was now available to be obtained by police. However, because the business is not open on Friday's, arrangements were made for the surveillance to be obtained by police on Saturday, March 29th, 2014.

This report is written by Sgt. David Ligas, District One, Late Power Shift, Sqd. 1413.

On the evening of Saturday May 3rd, 2014 through the morning of Sunday May 4th, 2014 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. The officers who participated in the operation were officers Robert FERRELL, District One, Power Shift, Jennifer RAMOS, District One, Late Shift, Anthony KRUEGER, District One, Early Shift, and myself. For the underage persons in this initiative we used two MPD police aides who work in the Police Administration Building. They were P.A. Paige CARLONI, W/F 12-15-93, Sensitive Crimes Day Shift, and P.A. Kourtney HARTL, W/F 06-18-94, Central Booking Day Shift.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed class B tavern establishments the police aides were given instructions. CARLONI and HARTL were told that they were not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. They could not lie if asked if they were underage, or show any form of documentation, which could be construed as identification. It was explained that they had to order a Miller Lite Beer, directly from a bartender behind a bar, then meet the plainclothes officer observing them with the alcoholic beverage for a photo in the tavern and then leave together. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes officer shadowing them would be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

After this briefing I escorted P.O. Anthony Krueger who was in plainclothes and P.A. HARTL. While P.O. FERRELL escorted P.O. RAMOS in plainclothes, and P.A. CARLONI to multiple taverns located throughout the District One boundaries.

P.A. CARLONI attempted to gained entry to the class "B" licensed tavern Apartment 720, 720 N Milwaukee St. P.A. CARLONI was challended at the point of entry and turned away when she couldn't prove she was of age.

Since there was no violation this tavern was not notified that this PA-33 was filed.

This report is written by P.O. Christopher PETERSON, 018563, assigned to District 1, Code Red Deployment, Squad 1431. On Sunday, June 1, 2014, P.O. Guadalupe RAMIREZ-CERVANTES (018945) and I were assigned to District 1, code red deployment, squad 1431. We were posted in the 700 block of N. Milwaukee Street.

At approximately 2:15 AM, Dicks and Apartment 720 establishments began to usher their patrons out of their premesis. Hundreds of subjects left the taverns and walked on while many loitered in front of the tavern. During this period, P.O RAMIREZ-CERVENTES and I assisted tavern employees in keeping subjects moving along from the location.

During the exodus of patrons from the listed establishment, the employees were helpful and asisted MPD in moving customers along and away from their entry door. At approximately 2:25 AM, P.O RAMIREZ-CERVENTES and I observed 4 or 5 subjects physically fighting in front of Dicks Pizza located at 730 N. Milwaukee Street. We ran about 75 feet North of our location to where the subjects were fighting. These subjects had fallen to the ground. We immediately separated the subjects before those individuals sustained injuries. During the course of performing our duties, I observed P.O RAMIREZ-CERVENTES to have fallen to his knees while assisting in separating the fighting subjects. It was at this point that P.O RAMIREZ-CERVENTES sustained an injury to the knuckles of his right hand. I observed the injury to be bleeding and consistent with knuckles being scraped on cement.

One of the subjects who participated in the listed fight was later identified as Svetlan BLAGOJEVIC, m/w, 06/15/1991. BLAGOJEVIC had to be told several times to leave the area. At approximately 2:29 AM, BLAGOJEVIC was observed by Sgt. Thomas ACKLEY, 018520 (District 1, power shift) to be retrieving a firearm from his vehicle and placing this firearm in his waistband. Sgt. ACKLEY recovered the firearm and arrested BLAGOJEVIC. BLAGOJEVIC was processed at District 2.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
