Description of work Existing sign located below the cornice predates the current occupant. The current business utilized the old curved framework from that earlier sign and added two panels that covered over the name of the earlier occupant. This sign will be removed and a new sign will be installed flat against the building in the old location. The sign will consist of a box with internal LED illumination, brushed brass halo lit channel cans and a black vinyl face. The letters spelling out "American Pub" will be cut out text with a Lexan backing. The sign will be

60 inches tall and 101 inches long.






