Dear Ms. Turenske:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$3,984.18, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle January 12, 2005 when it was allegedly hit by a garbage truck at 1237 East Vienna.

Our investigation reveals that the Fleet Accident Report completed as a result of this alleged incident notes that the driveway is very narrow and there are low overhead wires in the area. There is no evidence that a City garbage truck had backed-up the driveway and into the parking area where your vehicle was parked. This spot is some distance past the garbage carts. The damages to your vehicle do not line up with the equipment on the garbage truck. In addition, the driver also denies backing-up the driveway. There was also no paint transfer on the truck. Since there is no evidence to support your belief that a City garbage truck caused the damage, the City cannot accept liability. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
