This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA, assigned to District Two Early Shift. On Saturday, February 14, 201, at 1:36 pm, Squads 2264 (P.O. Jesus GLORIA) and 2268 (P.O. VODICKA) conducted a license premises check at "Taqueria y Pollos al Carbon el Parian" or "El Parian", located at 1631 W. Mitchell St., after receiving information from P.O. Efrain CORNEJO that he had heard a radio advertisement for the premises that mentioned the premises having a live band on today's date.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

#### PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Wednesday, August 6, 2014, while assigned to Squad 2268 (P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ and I) was informed by D.N.S. Special Inspector Lorie GALLUP that Reyna's Events & Mexican Restaurant (further referred to as "the premises"), located at 611 W. National Av. Milwaukee WI, was observed by D.N.S. Commercial Codes and Building supervisor Michael M. MANAN (M/W 03/19/74 841 N. Broadway Milwaukee, WI 53202 (414)286-3975) operating as a public entertainment premises without first obtaining a license to do so.

I did check the LIRA website (the License Information Reporting and Administration system for the City of Milwaukee, a database of individual and business licenses) and found that the premises had three pending licenses with the following statuses;

PEP 189364 Public Entertainment Premises – Pending Payment

FREST 187193 Food Dealer - Restaurant - Pending Aldermanic Approval

BTAVN 189341 Class B Tavern - Pending Committee Review

I did also receive a copy of an email from City Clerk, Jim OWCZARSKI (286-2998) to the licensee of the premises, Reyna G. MORALES (F/W 09/30/89 of 1701 S. 5th St Milwaukee, WI (414) 306-2216, dated 07/24/14, stating that a provisional license was being denied due to the fact that only renewal licenses are eligible for provisional licenses and that MORALES would have to wait until September 23, 2014, to have the license granted for the premises.

On Friday, August 8, 2014, at 2:22 pm, I spoke with MANAN by phone regarding his observations of the premises. MANAN stated that on Saturday, August 2, 2014, at 8:45 pm, he had stopped at a red traffic signal in the eastbound lane of the 600 block of W. National Av. And had observed that a party was taking place at the premises. MANAN further stated that he observed a D.J. booth and D.J. through the windows at the northeast corner of the building, which he knew to be "Reyna's". MANAN further stated that he observed "multi-colored dance lights", could hear disco/dance music, and observed the shadows of three or four subjects seated at tables which were decorated with balloons and ribbons. MANAN stated that he has been aware of and involved with the ongoing occupancy issues at 611 W. National Av. for the past year, particularly with the first floor restaurant space.

On Friday, August 08, 2014, at 4:40 pm, P.O. VELASQUEZ and I met with the licensee of the premises, Reyna MORALES, at District Two. I explained the concerns that I had that the premises had been offering public entertainment prior to being licensed to do so and that any and all activity would have to cease until the licenses were obtained. MORALES stated that she had hosted a baptism at the premises on the night of August 2nd, 2014, and acknowledged that there had been a D.J. playing music, but stated no one had been dancing, MORALES stated that the organizer of the event brought in food from a licensed caterer and that no alcohol had been served.

MORALES was issued a citation for Public Entertainment Premises-License Required and given a future court date.




