There is a possibility that your application may be ed for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/13/09 at 12:43 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 4747 N Hopkins St for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police attempted to enter the tavern but found the door locked. Police identified themselves and the bartender walked over to the cash register and buzzed the door allowing officers in. The bartender, identified as Theordis Terry, pointed out the victim and officers spoke with him. Investigation revealed the victim won some money while at the Potawatomi Bingo and had been at a couple of other bars before coming to Ealy's. Once at Ealy's, he bought a round of drinks. The victim stated he started talking to a girl who was with a guy or two and around 12:30 am he left the tavern. While walking to his car, the victim stated he could hear the girl talking on her cell phone telling someone he was leaving. Once at his car, a male approached him armed with a gun and a fight over the gun began. The suspect struck the victim once in the face with the gun causing it to discharge. The victim stated another suspect then ran up and punched him in the face. The suspects obtained the victim's car key's and cell phone and fled the scene. Officers spoke with Annabelle Ealy regarding the entry door being locked and Ealy stated she keeps it locked for her safety and buzzes patrons in after she gets a look at them. Ealy was advised that this violates city ordinance and that the door must remain unlocked or she will be cited.

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2. On 10/30/10 at 11:51 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a license premise check at 4747 N Hopkins Street. Officers spoke with Annabelle Rupert-Ealy and no violations were observed.

3. On 02/12/11 at 11:03 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Battery complaint at 4747 N Hopkins Street. Police spoke to the victim who stated another female who had a beer bottle attacked her causing the victim to sustain several lacerations to her face. The victim required 21 stitches to close the wounds. Police spoke with Annabelle Rupert-Ealy regarding this incident and Rupert-Ealy closed the tavern for the night so police could properly investigate.

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5. On 05/16/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at Ealy's 00 (4747 North Hopkins Street). Officers verified that the business had the licenses displayed.
6. On 01/17/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 4747 North Hopkins Street (Ealy's 00). At 1:35am there was a fight in the rear parking lot of the business. During the fight a subject was struck in the head with a pistol. The victim attempted to flee when an unknown armed suspect fired several rounds at the victims vehicle, striking the vehilce several times. Officers recovered 10 spent casings in the rear of the business. The agent stated it was motorcycle club night. The agent also stated she doesn't have security and the motorcycle club provides their own security.

This report was written by P.O. Brian LaROQUE, assigned to District Seven, Late Power Shift. I reviewed reports regarding a Reckless Use of Dangerous Weapon, and Substantial Battery that took place at 4747 N Hopkins St (Ealy's 00). The information I have received is based on the reports and my conversation with Annabelle (NMN) EALY (Owner) about the incident.

On 1/17/15 at approximately 1:35am there was a fight at the tavern that was in the rear parking lot of the business. The fight continued and a subject was struck in the head with a pistol causing injury. During the fight the victim attempted to flee the location when the unknown armed actor fired several rounds at the vehicle striking it several times. Based on the reports I see that officers located and recovered approximately 10 spent cartridge casings in the rear of the tavern.

I spoke with EALY who stated that it was a motorcycle club night and that the club was named Clique Riders. When I asked EALY who her security was for the night she informed me that she does not have any security there and that the motorcycle club provides their own security.

Phase 1

Observations outside the location

VEHICLES:

There were numerous vehicles parked in the rear parking lot, behind the bar. Officers observed several vehicles legally parked on W Hopkins St, in front of the bar.

CITIZENS:

When officers arrived on scene they observed several patrons leaving the tavern.

SECURITY AND DOOR COUNT:

I was at the location earlier in the night and observed a security guard at the front door and another at the back door. Both the front door and the rear door were using hand counters at the time of my arrival.

EXTERNAL SIGNAGE:

I did not observe any external signage at the location.

At the time officers arrived on scene patrons from the tavern were leaving the location and no estimation was conducted.

I also spoke with John M RUPERT regarding the incident. RUPERT is the nephew of EALY and is acting manager for the establishment. He cooperated with the investigation and allowed us immediate access to the security camera footage.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 4/28/2015 at 10:45 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
