Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

Pursuant to Article 58 of the 2007-2009 Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the Milwaukee Police Association, the City should request that this claim be placed on the Common Council Committee agenda within 180 days of its receipt.

This claim is being submitted under §895.35(2), STATS., which provides that:

Notwithstanding sub (1), the City . . . shall reimburse a protective services officer for reasonable attorney fees incurred by the officer in connection with a criminal proceeding arising from the officer's conduct in the performance of official duties, unless, in relation to that conduct, any of the following applies:

- The officer is convicted of a crime: a.
- Ъ. The officer's employment is terminated for cause:
- c. The officer resigned for reasons other than retirement before the attorneys fees are incurred;
- d. The officer is demoted or reduced in rank
- The officer is suspended without pay for 10 or more e. working days. \$895.35(2), ST.4TS.

Officer's Pajot, Arce and Lopez are all considered a "protective services officer" under the statute. They have incurred the fees compiled in this claim as a direct result of their being investigated for actions taken within their official capacity, and in the performance of their duties, in connection with the use of deadly force. None of the "exceptions" apply.

The incident resulted in the District Attorney's Office conducting a criminal investigation into the shooting of Mr. Victor Veloz, under Chapter 979, STATS. That investigation qualifies as a "proceeding" which mandates payment under §895.35(2), STATS.

Dear Chief Flynn:

On November 6, 2007. Victor Veloz was shot by Officer Alejandro Arce in the area of 1336 West Greenfield Avenue, in the City of Milwaukee. The shooting occurred after Veloz discharged a handgun into a police vehicle driven by officer Jose Lopez.

I personally investigated the shooting scene with Milwaukee County District Attorney investigators, and determined that Officers Arce, Lopez, and Patrick Pajot were in an unmarked squad responding to a dispatch for "shots fired" when they encountered Veloz in the near vicinity of the shooting. Veloz and his accomplice, Jose Fernandez, matched the description of two individuals suspected in the attempted homicide of two individuals prior to the encounter with the above listed officers (both individuals are now charged in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Court with felony counts for their actions).

Officer Lopez drove his squad towards Veloz to conduct a stop when he observed Veloz remove what Lopez believed to be a weapon from his waist area and start to direct the weapon at his squad. Lopez indicated that because of the short distance between himself and Veloz, he drove the squad towards Veloz to prevent Veloz from firing his weapon. Officer Lopez believes the squad may have struck Veloz but Veloz was still able to fire his weapon into the squad, with one round striking Officer Lopez. Officer Lopez did not discharge his weapon during this encounter.

Officer Arce was present with Officers Lopez and Pajot at 14th and Greenfield when he heard Vice Control officers call out over the radio that the suspects from the shooting scene were directly in front of their squad. Arce saw two individuals attempting to run east

on Greenfield Avenue and observed Officer Lopez drive on to the sidewalk. Arce attempted to get out of the squad car after it stopped and was immediately confronted by an armed gumman (Veloz) who fired directly at him from short range. Officer Arce says he went "numb" and did not know immediately where he was struck, but knew he was hit. Arce returned fire and heard Officer Lopez exclaim that he was hit. Arce continued to engage the shooter until the gumman fell on the sidewalk and put his hands in the air.

Arce also indicated that based on his personal and professional experience (he grew up in the vicinity of 14th and Greenfield) the squad car was easily identifiable as a police car. In addition Arce indicates that he had his identification displayed and that he identified himself as a police officer before the gunnan fired. I find his account credible and consistent with the evidence recovered from the scene as well as other witness accounts and statements made by the suspects themselves.

Based on the investigation I find Officer Lopez' and Arce's actions reasonable and a privileged use of force under the circumstances. The actions of Mr. Veloz and his accomplice were criminal in nature and posed significant risk to the officers and citizens in that area.

By this letter, I respectfully request that Officers Lopez and Arce be allowed to return to full duty.
