The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolutions for Common Council approval:

<u>2006 Consolidated Contract</u> This resolution amends Common Council File 051120 which approved the application, funding and expenditure of these funds. The amendment authorizes the acceptance of an additional \$25,000 for the introduction of the Plain Talk Initiative and incorporates budget and position changes. Only those budgets that have been changed are included.

<u>Parents as Teachers Curriculum Grant-</u> This new grant will be funded by the Children's Trust Fund of Wisconsin. The purpose of the project is to provide a comprehensive home visiting curriculum that will include nationally certified training for staff and to provide necessary supplies needed by families for a safe and healthy environment for their children.

<u>Bader Lead Abatement Grant -</u> This is new funding from the Helen Bader Foundation to fund lead abatement in 27 housing units.

<u>Covering Kids Grant -</u> This is continuation funding received from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation through Community Advocates. The grant assists low-income families in obtaining medical insurance, food stamps and other entitlements and to develop strategies to reach out to families of school children.

<u>Medical Assistance Outreach Grant</u> - This continuing grant is funded by the Greater Milwaukee Foundation through the Social Development Commission. The purpose of the grant is to assist low-income families in obtaining medical insurance and food stamps and to measure the impact of the Milwaukee Health Department's programs at three area Volunteer Income Tax Super Sites.
