This trial has been in effect for a substantial time period and we have not received any complaints. Therefore, we recommend a permanent removal of the parking restrictions.

This is in response to your request on behalf of local residents to install the above-captioned winter parking restrictions.

Department of Public Works staff has investigated this request and found that the above-captioned street has not met the recommended street width criteria to install the requested "No Parking When Snowfalls 4" or More" restriction, since this street has a street width of thirty feet, and the minimum recommended street width for a roadway to have this restriction posted is thirty-six feet.

However, in compliance with your request, this legislation will be prepared for consideration at the next Public Safety Committee meeting for this winter parking restriction.
