## Title

An ordinance granting a subterranean space lease to Renaissant Lafayette LLC for a subsurface soil stabilization facility in the public right-of-way in front of 2000 to 2038 North Prospect Avenue in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Aldermanic District.

## <u>Analysis</u>

Adoption of this ordinance will allow the granting and execution of a subterranean space lease between the City and Renaissant Lafayette LLC for purposes of installing soil nails as part of a subsurface soil stabilization facility to permit construction of two twenty-story condominium towers and other improvements as part of the Detailed Plan Development ("DPD") District known as Renaissant's Park Lafeyette under Common Council File No. 050580 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Aldermanic District.
