The Department of Neighborhood Service has inspected the premises located at the abovesubject address and does hereby find that the premises does not meet the requirements of section 90-37-3-b and c of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. Specifically, the premises does not contain the minimum 1200-sq. ft. stage area and the service of alcohol is not done in a lobby incidental to the stage. To my knowledge, there has not been any recognized works of art testified to before a common council committee.

Based on the above findings, this location is not suitable to be licensed as a center for the visual and performing arts.

Please consider this a request to revoke the visual and performing arts license at this location, unless or until the required conditions are met.
