The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolutions for Common Council approval:

<u>Fetal Infant Mortality Review Grant</u>- This is a continuing grant funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through the Black Health Coalition. The grant will resume the interdisciplinary review of infant deaths occurring in the City of Milwaukee to identify opportunities to reduce infant mortality and support families at risk.

<u>Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant-</u> This continuing grant from the Medical College of Wisconsin assesses the effectiveness of HIV risk reduction counseling delivered by a computer as opposed to a counselor. Effectiveness of various risk reduction counseling methods will be evaluated for potential future use in the clinic.

Wellpoint Outreach Grant -This is continuation funding received from the Wellpoint Foundation through Community Advocates. The purpose of the funding is to assist low income families in obtaining medical insurance and food stamps and other entitlements and to assist low income pregnant women and teens in obtaining medical insurance and other entitlements such as Women, Children and Infants (WIC) and Prenatal Care Coordination.
