
All work must conform to the drawings as submitted. Any changes to size, material or design must be reviewed with Historic Preservation staff.








Metal fence will be installed around perimeter of property. Circled areas at corners and gates indicate larger 6" dimension posts




New bluestone patio to be installed between house and garage

ENTRANCE ARBOR








Entrance arbor to be located at south end of patio. Back arbor or pergola will be located at north end of patio.
